

NYPD MOS HURRICANE SANDY ASSISTANCE

ALL MEMBERS OF THE SERVICE WHOSE HOMES IN NEW YORK CITY HAVE BEEN AFFECTED BY HURRICANE SANDY SHOULD REGISTER FOR NYC RAPID REPAIR. THIS CITY/FEMA SPONSORED PROGRAM WILL MAKE YOUR HOMES SECURE, SANITARY AND HABITABLE. IN ORDER TO REGISTER FOR THE PROGRAM, THE MEMBER MUST HAVE A FEMA ID NUMBER. THE APPLICATION FOR NYC RAPID REPAIR CAN BE COMPLETED ON LINE AT:

THIS SHOULD BE DONE IMMEDIATELY AS REPAIRS ARE SCHEDULED ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE BASIS. TO ASSIST MEMBERS OF THE SERVICE WHO SUFFERED CATASTROPHIC LOSSES CAUSED BY HURRICANE SANDY, WALK-IN FAMILY RESOURCE CENTERS HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED IN STATEN ISLAND, BROOKLYN AND QUEENS. THESE WALK-IN CENTERS WILL PROVIDE DONATED SUPPLIES AND OFFER MEMBERS ASSISTANCE WITH FILING FEMA CLAIMS. IN ADDITION, THE MEDICAL DIVISION WILL HAVE STAFF PRESENT AT ALL THREE WALK-IN CENTERS AND ARE AVAILABLE FOR A MEDICAL SCREENING AND TO SPEAK TO COUNSELORS IF REQUESTED.

WALK-IN FAMILY RESOURCE CENTERS HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED IN STATEN ISLAND, BROOKLYN AND QUEENS.

ALL THE WALK-IN CENTERS WILL HAVE A LARGE AMOUNT OF ITEMS THAT INCLUDE NEW AND DONATED CLOTHING, COATS (ADULT AND CHILDREN), WATER AND FOOD, BABY FOOD/FORMULA, DIAPERS, TOILETRIES, BLANKETS, CLEANING SOLUTIONS, MOPS, BUCKETS, BROOMS, SPACE HEATERS, PET FOOD/SUPPLIES, "BOXED" CLEANING KITS, WHICH INCLUDES WORK AND LATEX GLOVES, DUST MASKS, FLASHLIGHTS & BATTERIES, BLEACH, GARBAGE BAGS.

THE WALK-IN FAMILY RESOURCE CENTERS WILL BE STAFFED SEVEN DAYS A WEEK UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE FROM 0700 HRS, X 1900 HRS.
