

MASTER OF ARTS - HUMAN RESOURCES TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT

Seton Hall University offers a Master's Degree Program in Human Resources Training and Development (HRTD) in two models: **on-line** and **traditional** classroom. The **on-line** program makes it convenient to earn a graduate degree without the weekly travel. This 24-month, 36-credit hour program is offered exclusively in learning teams. The M.A.H.R.T.D. is a "blended" program, completed largely on-line, with only three required weekend campus residencies January 2010 - September 2010 - May 2011. The **tradition** program meets on weekends at an off-campus site in Fort Lee, NJ., where literally hundreds of NYPD personnel have graduated and some continued onward to post-graduate studies. This site, located on the NJ plaza of the GWB, makes the commute extremely convenient and out of the traffic bullet. It follows the same requirements, i.e.: 36 credits, two year track on the average. The faculty is composed of mostly retired law enforcement personnel –including the NYPD, with earned graduate and doctoral degrees. AMOS receives a 50% discount on tuition.
